NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The prescriptions of the National Class E Scow Association (NCESA) and the Grand Lake Yacht Club (GLYC) will apply.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located at the Grand Lake Yacht Club.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats who are active members of the National Class E Scow Association (NCESA).
- 2.2 Off lake boats need to be checked by Parks and Wildlife for Zebra Mussels before launching at East end of lake

3 FEES

3.1 Registration fees will be \$150.00 for each boat and crew. Registration will include Friday evening festivities, lunches on Saturday and Sunday, and dinner on Saturday evening.

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration:

Friday, June 28, 2019, from 2:00pm to 5:00pm Saturday, June 29, 2019, from 8:00am to 10:00am

4.2 Dates of racing:

Saturday, June 29, 2019 Sunday, June 30, 2019

4.3 Number of races: This is a planned 5 race regatta. One race will constitute a regatta.

- 4.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 10:55am. When not sailing back-to-back, subsequent starting times will be posted on the official notice board.
- 4.5 On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 3:00pm.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration and at the Competitor's Meeting.

6 VENUE

The sailing area will be the navigable waters of Grand Lake.

7 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. [DP]

8 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: The top three boats will be awarded prizes.

9 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
